

**NOTICE OF 2010 BOARD OF REVIEW FOR THE TAXPAYERS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROSE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that the Board of Review of the Township of Rose will meet at the *Rose Township Offices, 9080 Mason Street*, Holly, Michigan (located in “Rose Center”) as follows:

**Tuesday, March 2, 2010**

2:00 PM to receive the 2009 Assessment Roll from the Assessor [MCL211.29(1)]

**Wednesday, March 10, 2010**

9:00 AM – 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM for appointments

**Thursday, March 11, 2010**

1:00 PM – 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM for appointments

**Wednesday, March 17, 2010**

1:00 PM – 6:00 PM for appointments

The 2010 tentative equalization ratio is 50% and the estimated multiplier is 1.0000 for all property classifications.

Any questions regarding the value placed on your property can be reviewed by the assessing department. After reviewing, if you wish to appeal the assessment further, arrangements can be made for an appointment before the Board of Review.

Protest at the Board of Review is necessary to protect your right to further appeals to the Michigan Tax Tribunal for valuation and exemption appeals and/or State Tax Commission for classifications appeals. The Board of Review considers appeals by appointment during the times listed above. All appearances to the Board will be by Appointment Only. Appearances before the Board of Review are limited to fifteen (15) minutes or less. If you or your representative want to appear in person, the appointment must be made on or before 12:00 PM, Wednesday, March 10, 2010. You may schedule an appointment by calling the Rose Township (248) 634-7551 during regular office hours (10:30 AM to 6:30 PM Monday and 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM, Tuesday through Thursday).

Please refer to the Parcel Identification Number to identify your property so that your records can be quickly located.

Resident property owners may appeal their assessment in writing provided a written appeal is received by the Board of Review by 5:00 PM on March 17, 2010.
