Notice of Public Hearing on the Special Assessment Roll for
Maintenance of Williams Drive, Rose Township, Oakland County, Michigan

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, to the residents and property owners of land within the **Williams Drive Road Maintenance Assessment District #008 (all properties adjacent to Williams Drive, Rose Township, Oakland County, Michigan)** and any other interested persons that the supervisor and assessing officer of the township has reported to the township board and filed in the office of the township clerk for public examination, a special assessment roll prepared by him covering all properties within the proposed Williams Drive Road Maintenance Assessment District #008. Said assessment roll has been prepared for the purpose of assessing the costs of road maintenance within the district which assessment is in the total amount of \$4,515.68 for the first year and \$3,914.00 for each subsequent year. The term of the Williams Drive Road Maintenance Assessment District #008 is five years.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that the assessing officer has further reported that the assessment against each parcel of land within said district is an amount that is the relative portion of the whole sum to be levied equally against each parcel of land in the S.A.D. as the benefit to the parcel of land bears to the total benefit to all parcels of land in the S.A.D.

NOTICE IS FURTHER NOTICE, that the township board will meet at the Rose Township Hall, 204 Franklin Street, Holly, Michigan on Wednesday, April 13, 2011 at 7:30 P.M. for the purpose of reviewing said special assessment roll and hearing any objections thereto. Said roll may be examined at the office of the township clerk during regular business hours of regular business days until the time of said hearing and may further be examined at said hearing. Appearance and protest at the hearing held to confirm the special assessment roll is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal.

An owner, or party in interest, or his or her agent may appear in person at the hearing to protest the special assessment, or shall be permitted to file his or her appearance or protest by letter and his or her personal appearance shall not be required. The owner or any person having an interest in the real property who protests in person or in writing at the hearing may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal within 30 days after the confirmation of the special assessment roll.
