Explained the NSP process, which started last September or October. The goals are to diminish housing vacancy rates, reverse the decline to neighborhood housing values, and stabilize neighborhoods impacted by foreclosure and abandonment. NSP helps reduce blight and does not have any foreclosure number and percent of home foreclosures and they determined \$17,383,776 would come to Oakland County and allocate the funds down to the local communities. Rose Township will receive \$524,763 in NSP funds to address abandoned or foreclosed properties of the highest need.
