- Clerk

 - Public Accuracy Test is this Wed, Sep 23, at 11am
- Treasurer
 - Because of the pending forensic audit, questions arose regarding shredding routine documents (how, what, when). Also, there are election documents that are scheduled for shredding according to the retention schedule - Clerk Miller will consult with Atty. Delzer
- Building/Zoning
 - Board agreed to one more mowing at Water Street/Munger Rd; will determine how to recoup Township costs
 - The Planning Commission members are signed up for an MTA online class regarding data centers
 - There are two issues on the November 5 Planning Commission agenda – special land use at 9100 Joel Rd, and Additional Dwelling Units
- Trustee Bourdeau
 - Volunteer waiver – she has not heard from Atty. Delzer, and Clerk Miller has not had a callback from the Township insurance provider
- Treasurer Jobes
 - Out of town next week and not at Monday meeting
 - Will discuss unacceptable meeting behavior (walking out of the meeting) with Supervisor Stilwell
