

## **Public Notice: Beware of False IRS Form 1098-SR Claims**

**Rose Township is advising residents to be aware of false information circulating on social media and in online videos regarding a supposed IRS “Form 1098-SR.”**

### **IRS Form 1098-SR does not exist.**

Online claims stating that the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has introduced a “Form 1098-SR” that allows senior citizens to freeze, cap, or reduce their property taxes are **false and are associated with an online scam.**

Residents should **not provide personal, financial, Social Security, or property information** to websites, individuals, or social media accounts promoting this supposed form. Do not pay a fee to obtain, submit, or process a “Form 1098-SR.”

Property tax exemptions, credits, deferrals, and other forms of relief for senior citizens are established through legitimate state and local programs—not through a federal IRS Form 1098-SR.

### **Protect Yourself**

- Do not click links or download forms from questionable social media posts or videos.
- Do not provide personal or financial information in response to these claims.
- Verify federal tax forms and programs directly through the **IRS at IRS.gov.**
- Contact the appropriate local or state government office if you have questions about legitimate property tax relief programs.
